Documentary Film, 55 minutes, that examines the plight of the Palestinian, indigenous Christian Arab population – the direct descendants of the first followers of Jesus. They are often called the forgotten faithful in the current Middle East crisis. Media coverage generally portrays Palestinians as Muslims when in fact they include both Muslims and Christians. Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus, is now hemmed in by the “wall,” cut off from Jerusalem and robbed of much of its agricultural land. This film is all the more important for understanding the issues currently being discussed in peace talks between Israelis and Palestinians under the auspices of Secretary of State John Kerry.
